Easter Egg Garland

This low-key activity will allow a child to use their creativity while mastering their fine motor skills!

Space:

Table with plastic covering

Supplies:

Colored paper Pencil Scissors Hole punch String



Egg shaped cookie cutter (optional)

Items to decorate eggs such as: stickers, markers, paint, glitter

Instructions:

- 1. Draw egg shapes on paper using cookie cutter or freehand
- 2. 2Cut the egg shapes using scissors
- 3. 3Decorate the eggs using materials of your choice
- 4. Once eggs are decorated, use a hole punch to add two holes at the top of each egg
- 5. Thread the eggs onto string
- 5. Thread the eggs onto strif
- 6. Hang up garland!

Fluffy Easter Slime

This low-key activity will allow a child to independently play and enjoy a tactile sensory experience!

Space:

Table with plastic covering (will get messy!)

Supplies:

1/2 cup White Washable PVA School Glue 3 cups Foam Shaving Cream 1 tbsp Saline Solution or Contact Solution 1/4-1/2 tsp Baking Soda

Food Coloring (optional)



Instructions:

- 1. Put 3-4 cups of foam shaving cream into a large mixing bowl.
- 2. Add food coloring if desired and gently stir.
- 3. Add 1/2 cup of white glue to your bowl. Gently stir to combine.
- 4. Add 1/2 teaspoon of baking soda to the mixture and gently stir.
- 5. Add 1 tablespoon of saline solution (must contain borate ions) to the bowl.
- 6. Whip the mixture to activate the slime. It will begin to pull away from sides and bottom of bowl.
- 7. Pick up your slime and knead it until smooth and stretchy and no longer sticky.
