Good-day Aggi,

We have spent \$18,392.14 on Rawlin's Cross to date.  
With the non recoverable portion of tax (4.5%) this gives \$19,219.79 of spending.

This does not include costs that the City would have incurred anyway, or can use on other projects in future, like staff time and reusable supplies.

The projected capital cost to make the proposed Rawlin's Cross change is not yet known. It will depend on the final design which will be driven by the evaluation that is currently underway and the decisions of Council.
