You may also appeal directly to the Supreme Court Trial Division within 15 business days after you receive the decision of the public body, pursuant to Section 52 of the Act.

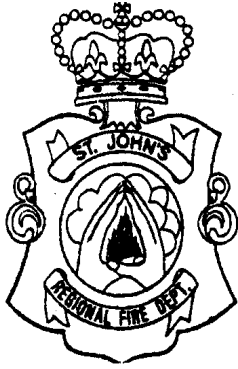

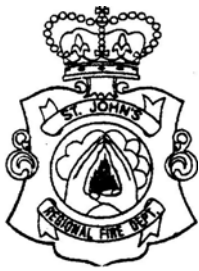

<p>E-1 10-12. Advised that two pts. in elevator stuck between floors. Advised Thypus Trupp called and zero return phone call as to if and when tech was to arrive. I called Trupp emergency line and call redirected many times. Advised by nursing/care staff that pts. with numerous medical conditions and needed to be removed from elevator. Used a haligan tool to partially pry door as tech. arrived. Tech spent app. 12-15 minutes at elevator control room. Second tech. arrived and were able to return elevator to floor. Crew able to re-track door and now in working condition.</p> <p>Staff advised that prior to FD arrival, 6-7 attempts to return elevator to floor by de-energizing and re-energizing elevator main power switch were preformed. Power switch with label of 600 Volts. Instructed staff to not continue with this practice and that switch was for emergency shut down of elevator and zero attempts to be made to re-energize. For similar occurrences staff was instructed to call both Thypus Trupp and FD.</p> <p>Trupp Tech.=Shawn Wade.</p> <p>Will forward call particular to Cpt. Marr in Fire Prevention/Inspection.</p>
