Discussion – Background and Current Status:

The 200th Anniversary Royal St. John's Regatta Committee ("the Committee"), in 2016 had a document produced entitled the "Quidi Vidi Park Master Plan". The Plan described the Quidi Vidi Park Redevelopment in concept form.
