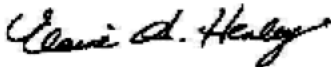



I am writing in support of the proposed movement of the Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association (NADA) facility to the site identified (163 Doyle's Road). This letter addresses the importance of and the method of Dog Training NADA uses with our human and 4 legged community members.

I myself have been training dogs locally for approximately twenty seven years. For eight of those years, I have been the only Certified Behavior Adjustment Trainer (CBATI) in Newfoundland. As a CBATI my primary focus is helping my clients whose dogs are fearful, frustrated and or aggressive. In other words I deal with dogs that are reactive. I am a Canine Good Neighbor evaluator registered with the Canadian Kennel Club, a credited Fun Scent Games Instructor and a certified Canine Games Theory Instructor. I have studied on line courses/learning such as Grisha Stewarts Animal Building Blocks Academy, Play Your Way Academy, One Happy Dog, DPF Agility, Karen Pryor Clicker Training courses; Susan Garrets Recallers, Puppy Peeks, Nosework Courses and fifty three on line learning classes with the Fenzi Dog Sport Academy. I occasionally teach classes with the Newfoundland Kennel Club and I volunteer my time at Humane Services training the shelter dogs in hopes of making them "more" adoptable. I also am a member of the Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association both in the capacity as an instructor and as a student.

The Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association (NADA) has been a viable community organization for the past ten years. NADA's philosophy on dog training is a Modern Day Progressive one. They provide their clients with humane and scientifically supported training methods that utilize a **force free and positive based system of teaching**. This means NADA teaches all skills and games without the use of any aversive/punishment and or corrections of any kind. This would include **banning** the use of inhumane training tools such as prong collars , shock collars , choke collars, bark collars and spray bottles; the use of any physical corrections such as yanking the leash for pulling and /or hands on corrections such as hitting, hanging or pushing the dog to the ground. NADA also does not condone the use of any verbal punishment directed toward dogs.

As a valued member of the Dog Training Community, one in which I had to sign a Progressive Reinforcement Training Manifesto I advocate and more importantly science supports that the use of such **outdated** training methods comes with serious fall outs and side effects. They are inhumane, inhibit learning, disempowering, they suppress behavior, they can cause an increase in aggression and they do not teach the dog what it is we want them to do.

NADA has the opportunity to continue to help owners train their dogs in our community utilizing the best training methods. I highly recommend the city pass and allow the Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association to move their facility to 163 DoYLES Road.

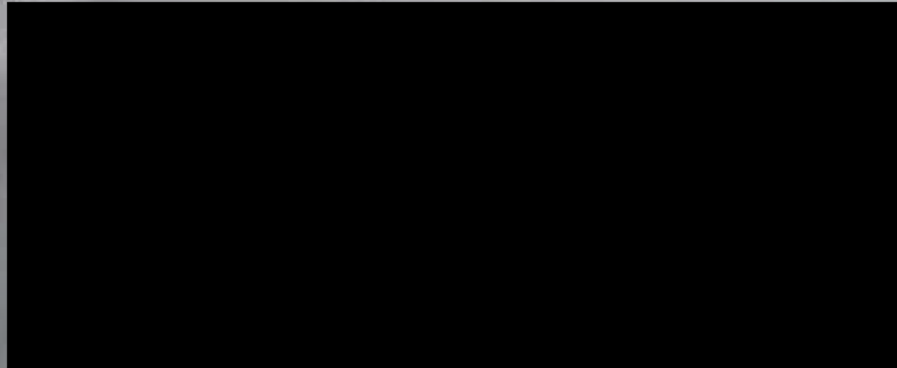

Dear Members of City Council,

I'm writing to you regarding the **163 Doyle Road, Dog Training Facility notice**. I am one of the founding members of Newfoundland Athletic Dog Association, Inc. Back in 2006, when I moved to St. John's for work, there was no agility here in the province, let alone the City. I have been training and competing in the sport of agility since 1994. I have competed or trained in all the provinces of Canada, except BC and MB. I travel to U.K. and across Canada to train, and I am the only AAC agility judge in NL.

Agility is a dog sport that started in England mid-1980s as a family-oriented half-time show for a large equine competition. It has become immensely popular worldwide. There are World-level, National-level, Regional, and local competitions. We also host fun events for those who rather play than compete in the sport. The fundamental principle of agility is that it is a fun and safe sport for all members of the family, from the child (junior handlers are individuals who are ~8-10 years of age to 18 years of age) to the adult and seniors (the oldest competitor I have personally seen in the sport in Canada was in her 80s). It is an inclusive sport for all persons of varied abilities. All dogs, regardless of breed and history, are welcome to the sport, *provided they are mentally and physically sound*.

NADA, Inc. follows these principles of inclusivity, safety, family-friendly sport. We have taught junior handlers, seniors and everyone in between. We have had handlers of a wide range of physical capabilities take our classes from an individual in a wheelchair, individuals with limited mobility for a variety of reasons, to former and current athletes. We have also served as a safe haven for individuals healing from psychological stress (e.g., PTSD, OCD, depression). We engender a positive club environment of respect and fun.

What I am most proud of with the club is the impact it has had on the greater community in terms of improving dog training methods. When I moved here, force-based training methods were commonly used. There was one individual, who moved away, providing small, basic training classes with clicker-training. In my agility classes, I fostered the inclusive and respectful culture, and taught evidence-based training methods that were non-force.

In the past ten years, we have supported the expansion of non-force methods training and there has been a tangible shift in the community now because of it. Students and members learn how to improve their relationship with their dogs, while having a lot of fun. The additional benefit people and dogs get from our offerings is increased physical and mental activity in a positive, structured and supportive environment, which is so important for overall health and vitality of a community. In addition, two entrepreneurs were birthed from our organization (Dynamic Canine, A Rock Solid Dog), along with a second organization (NL Search & Rescue), which also benefits the economy and engagement of the Community.

Our club's existence is fully dependent on having an appropriate home for our sports. There once was agility in Newfoundland in the early 1990's, but it died because of the lack of a home. Since the start of March, we have spent all our energy into finding a new home; 163 Doyle Rd. is *the only option* that allows us to continue offering all that we do for the public and our members. It has been 10 years of dedication and care that this club has come to be known as a really great resource for dog owners in the City, region, and province.

I sincerely hope the Council agrees and continues to support our presence in the community by approving this application.

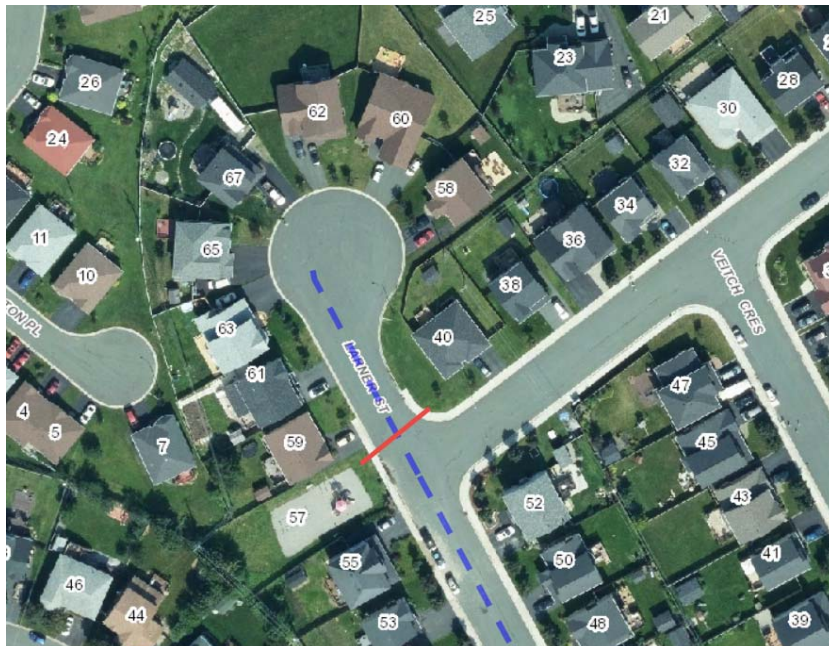

The amendments to the City's Election Finance By-law incorporate and reflect these changes to the Provincial statute.

ELECTION FINANCE (AMENDMENT NO. 1, 2017) BY-LAW

PASSED BY COUNCIL ON _____, 2017

Pursuant to the powers vested in it under the Municipal Elections Act, RSNL 1990 c. M-20.2, as amended and all other powers enabling it, the City of St. John's enacts the following By-Law relating to municipal election finances.

BY-LAW

1. This By-Law may be cited as the "St. John's Election Finance (Amendment No. 1, 2017) By-Law".
2. Section 2(a) of the St. John's Election Finance By-Law is repealed and the following substituted:

"2 (a) contribution means a contribution of money, goods, or services, but does not include a donation by a natural person of his or her personal services, talents, or expertise or the use of his or her vehicle where it is given freely and not as part of his or her work in the service of an employer."
3. Section 4(1) of the St. John's Election Finance By-Law is repealed and the following substituted:

"4(1) (a) Contributions to candidates shall be made only by natural persons individually, or by corporations or trade unions individually.

(b) The value of goods or services contributed to a candidate is:

(i) if the contributor is in the business of supplying those goods or services, the lowest amount charged by the contributor for an equivalent amount of the same goods or services at or about the time and in the market area in which the goods or services are contributed; and

- (ii) if the contributor is not in the business of supplying those goods or services, the lowest amount charged, at or about the time the goods or services are provided, by another person who provides the same goods on a commercial retail basis or services on a commercial basis in the market area in which the goods or services are contributed.”
 - (c) For greater certainty, where an employee spends time working for a candidate for which he or she is compensated by his or her employer and the employer is not a candidate, the value of that compensation is a contribution of the employer for the purposes of this By-Law.
- 4. Section 4(5) of the St. John’s Election Finance By-Law is repealed and the following substituted:

“4(5) Money given to a candidate in an amount exceeding \$250.00 shall be made only:

 - (a) by a cheque that has the name of the contributor printed legibly on it and that is signed by the contributor and drawn on an account in the contributor’s name;
 - (b) by a money order that identifies the name of the contributor; or
 - (c) in the case of a contribution by an individual by the use of a credit card, if that credit card has the name of the individual contributor imprinted or embossed on that card,

and that contribution shall not be accepted unless the contribution is made in accordance with this subsection.”
- 5. The following is added as section 4(7):

“4(7) Where goods or services in an amount exceeding \$250.00 are anonymously contributed to a candidate, those goods or services shall not be utilized by the candidate in the election.”
- 6. The following is added as section 6.1:

“6.1 A statement filed under this By-Law shall be considered to be an official record of the City, and upon request, shall be made available for inspection by members of the public.”
