WHEREAS: Treating Hidradenitis Suppurativa (HS) is a challenge for both patients and

physicians as no one treatment works for everyone, some treatments lose effectiveness over time, many treatments are used in combination with other treatments and all treatments may cause a unique set of side effects; and

WHEREAS: The understanding and acceptance of the general public is an important factor

in patients' treatment and health, and Hidradenitis Suppurativa Awareness Week provides an opportunity to increase awareness, correct misconceptions, promote education and support, recognize the struggles of those effected, and

shorten the delay in diagnosis; and

WHEREAS: In person awareness activities are not possible this year, however, support for

patients continues during social distancing with support via phone and online and the medical treatment and care for patients continues, both virtually and

in person when necessary; and

THEREFORE: Be It Resolved That I, Mayor Danny Breen, do hereby proclaim this week as
